WINE OF ORIGIN:

Darling

VITICULTURE:

The grapes for Project Z Grenache 2020 were sourced from an old bush-vine vineyard in the cool-climate region of Darling on the Cape West Coast. Growing untamed and unbridled in sandy soils and subjected to the maritime airflow off the Atlantic Ocean, the vineyard was selected for its ability to grow grapes offering a superior expression of the site's unique geography.

VINIFICATION:

Whole bunch fermented in Italian clay amphorae and stainless-steel tanks with a further 12 months of maturation in an amphora and seasoned oak barrels for the respective components. Captures the essence of this unique vineyard in a red wine of singular personality exuding freshness, focus and texture.

WINEMAKER'S NOTE:

Rose petal, lavender, and raspberries on the nose with hints of spice. The palate shows pure fruit and a velvety texture balanced by zippy acidity, and a spicy dry grip of tannins on the long finish.
